Bicycle Pedestrian Commission Project Engagement Policies



CUPERTINO

March 16, 2022

BPC Mission per Municipal Code

1. To monitor and update the Bicycle Transportation Plan and Pedestrian Transportation Guidelines;
2. To suggest recommendations, review, and monitor the City's General Plan Transportation Element;
3. To receive public input pertaining to bicycle and pedestrian transportation and infrastructure issues;
4. To make recommendations regarding the implementation of roadway and transportation improvements as it pertains to bicycle and pedestrian needs;
5. To make recommendations regarding the allocation of funds for capital expenditures relating to bicycle and pedestrian transportation;
6. Any other activity that may be deemed appropriate and necessary.

Proposal for Future Project Engagement

- Bike or Ped projects which involve a permanent change to vertical elements within the street between existing curbs
 - Possible exception: Plastic post bulb-outs
- Bike or Ped projects which will be heard as a Council discussion item
 - Exception: Items requested by Council to be heard directly
- Staff recommendations for active traffic control devices (e.g., stop signs, traffic signals, crossing guards).
- Council requests for BPC recommendation
- All items falling within Mission Statement

One Bay Area Grant Cycle 2 Congestion Mitigation Air Quality federal funds

- 1) Approve reprogramming approximately \$3.239 million One Bay Area Grant Cycle 2 Congestion Mitigation Air Quality federal funds to the following projects:
 - a) **Cupertino-Stevens Creek Blvd. Class IV Bikeway - \$807,000** ; and
 - b) Los Gatos-Los Gatos Creek Trail to Highway 9 Trailhead Connector - \$2,432,000; and

- 2) Approve any additional relinquished OBAG Cycle 2 funds (up to \$919,000) to the Los Gatos-Los Gatos Creek Trail to Highway 9 Trailhead Connector should they become available.
