

## Proclamation

WHEREAS, The City of Cupertino wishes to recognize the resolution passed

unanimously by the Human Rights Council of the United Nations

(U.N.) declaring that access to a healthy and sustainable

environment is a universal human right;

WHEREAS, We currently live in a world in which many millions of people,

growing in number, face the devastating consequences of the ongoing climate crisis, pollution, loss of biodiversity, and the lack

of clean, safe water;

WHEREAS, In 2014, the City of Cupertino crafted and implemented a Climate

Action Plan, significantly reducing greenhouse gas emissions, investing in a walkable and bikeable community, and engaging

with community partners to create a healthier environment;

WHEREAS, The City of Cupertino will continue to promote a clean

environment by, for example, building a roadmap to a carbonneutral City by 2040, protecting the environment, and reducing and eliminating the use of fossil fuels to remain a leader in demonstrating how local decisions can invigorate climate action

around the world;

WHEREAS, The City of Cupertino stands with the United Nations in

supporting the implementation and protection of the human right

to a safe, clean, healthy, and sustainable environment for all.

**THEREFORE,** I, Mayor Darcy Paul, and the Cupertino City Council do hereby

Proclaim its support of the U.N.'s resolution for the

Human Right to a Clean and Healthy Environment

for everyone, and the City will continue advocating for, and taking action to ensure, a safe, sustainable environment in the promotion of universal and equitable human rights throughout the world and in the City of Cupertino.
