SPECIAL MEETING

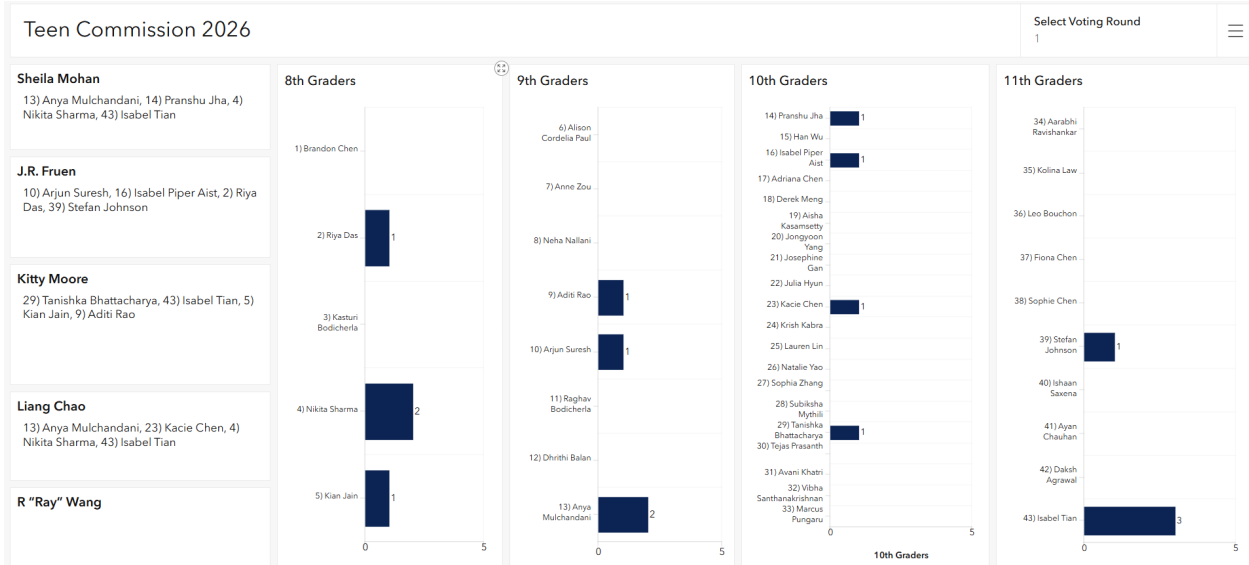

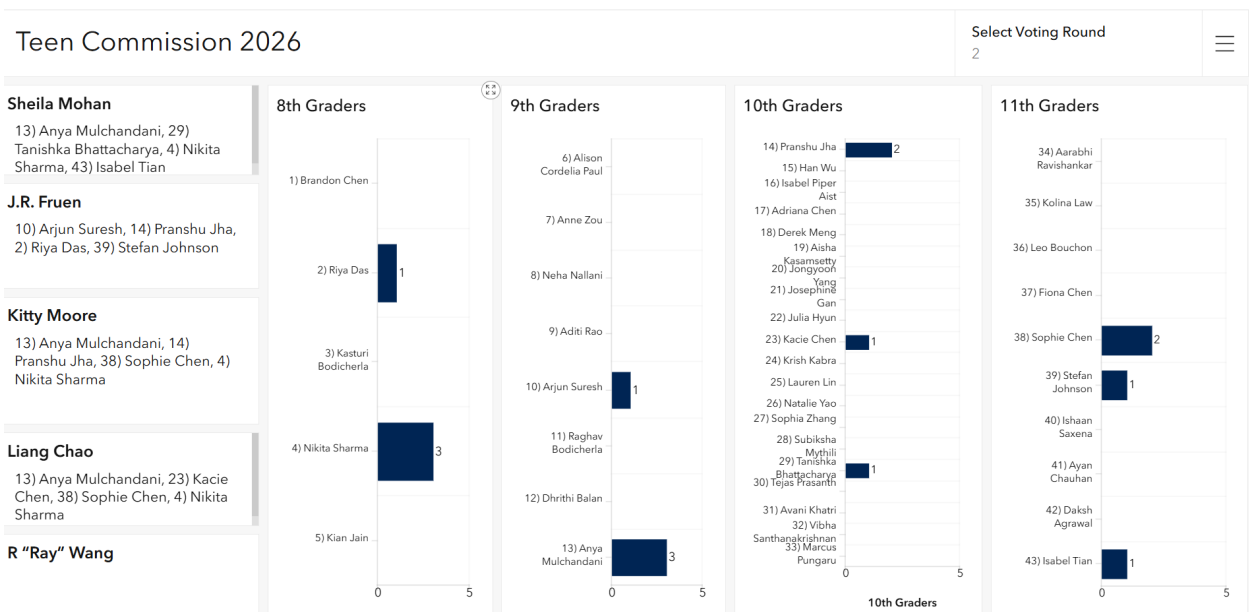

Teen Commission

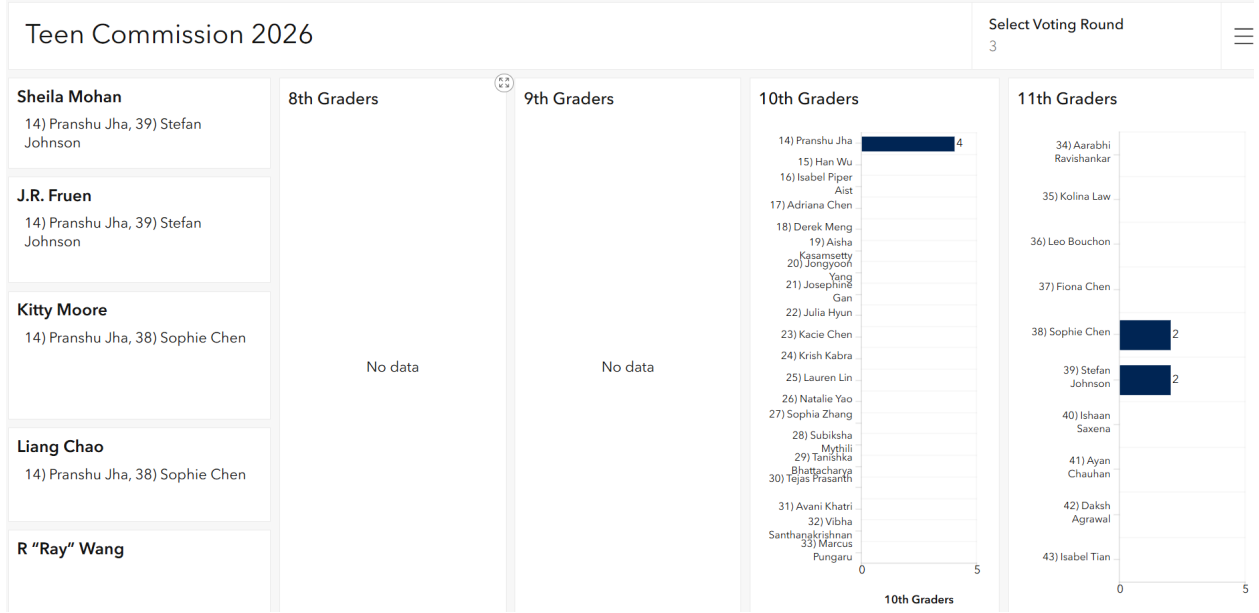

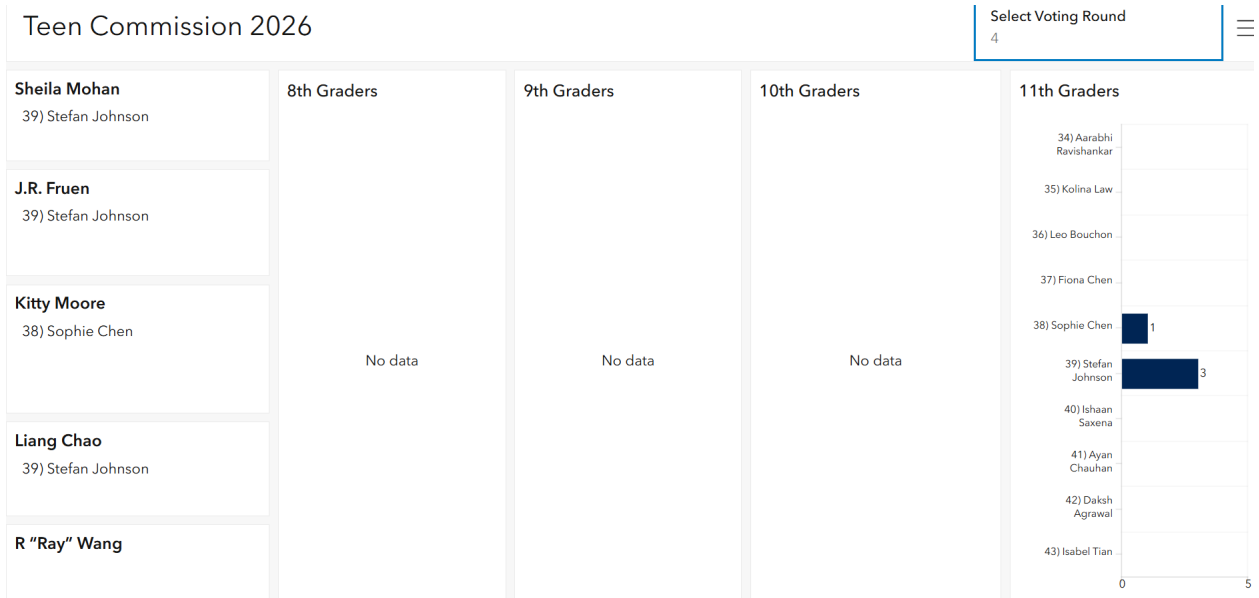

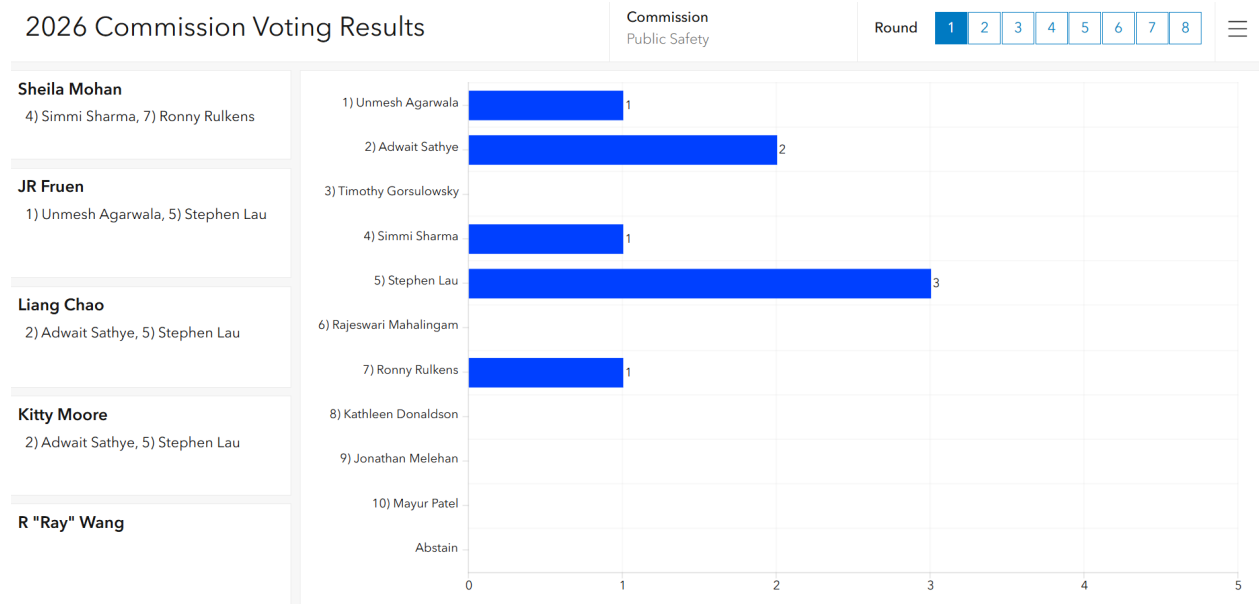
