CITY COUNCIL STAFF REPORT

Subject

First amendment to the Agreement Creating the Santa Clara County Recycling and Waste Reduction Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) to allow members to participate in TAC meetings using teleconference technology pursuant to Brown Act provisions.

Recommended Action

Authorize the City Manager to execute the first amendment to the Agreement Creating the Santa Clara County Recycling and Waste Reduction TAC to allow members to participate in TAC meetings using teleconference technology pursuant to Brown Act provisions.

Reasons for Recommendation

In 2013, jurisdictions in Santa Clara County (County), together with the County itself, executed the Agreement Creating the Santa Clara County Recycling and Waste Reduction Technical Advisory Committee (Committee). This organization advises the County Recycling and Waste Reduction Commission (Commission) and executes projects of mutual benefit. The Committee is funded by the Countywide Solid Waste Planning Fee, which is collected on material originating in the County and which is disposed of in landfills. The Commission advises city councils within the County and the County Board of Supervisors on countywide solid waste and recycling planning issues.

The 2013 TAC agreement requires in-person attendance at meetings, with limited and restrictive participation through virtual means, including no voting authority when attending virtually. Teleconference requirements for the TAC are currently more stringent than those of the Brown Act. Given the progress in teleconferencing technology and the normalizing of remote participation because of the pandemic, the jurisdictions now desire to amend the agreement to allow remote participation in accordance with Brown Act provisions. The proposed amendments to the TAC Agreement enable remote participation consistent with Brown Act requirements.

Sustainability Impact

Allowing remote participation through teleconferencing reduces the cumulative amount of greenhouse gas emissions from each attending member of the public, staff, and voting members throughout the county who commute to participate in meetings.

Fiscal Impact
