Item Date, Title, and Description:

January 14, 2026. Press Conference with Mayor Matt Mahan, and other electeds RE funding for Prop 36. Spoke in favor of fully implementing the strongly voter supported proposition.

January 15, 2026. Prep session RE Dividend Homes project with Staff.

January 15, 2026. VTA Policy Advisory Committee. Requested the Measure B “placemat” include the estimated total project costs so that it would provide more meaningful information for the PAC and Board. Requested clarification on what may be internal inconsistencies in the Complete Streets Policy.
