Item Date, Title, and Description:

3/18/26: Along with Mayor Moore, welcomed a **student delegation from Copertino, Italy**. The students were shown around the Community Hall, City Hall and the Library, and it was fun to see the enthusiasm and energy they exuded. Thank you to City Staff for organizing the students' activities and the commendations presented to the staff and students.

3/22/26 Attended the annual **League of Women Voters Meet and Greet** event where elected officials from local jurisdictions gathered to network and connect with each other. This was a well-attended and enjoyable event and an opportunity to engage with community leaders about topics of mutual interest.

3/23/26 Attended a **neighborhood block party** where representatives from the Sheriff's office spoke about how to keep homes safe during the upcoming summer season, and the resources available to the community to increase protection and safety.

3/24/26 Participated in a Zoom meeting with representatives from Summerhill, the developers for **the Evulich Ct** housing site. Communicated the concerns of the community and stressed the importance of working closely with all stakeholders.

3/25/26 In my role as a member of the **County of Santa Clara Housing and Community Development Advisory Committee**, I attended the annual meeting at the Board of Supervisors Chambers. The committee discussed the process for awarding community block grants and made comments about individual

beneficiary groups. For Cupertino, West Valley Community Services was awarded \$15,000 in funding.

3/27/26 Along with Vice Mayor Chao, I attended the quarterly strategy meeting of the **School Partnership and School Liaison** group. The CUSD and FUHSD superintendents provided updates on their budget, new initiatives like the Robotics Center at Cupertino High School, and recognition of Lawson and Kennedy Middle Schools as California Distinguished Schools.

This is a unique charity event / fund raiser that invites celebrity local chefs to prepare the banquet dinner using ingredients from the West Valley pantry.
