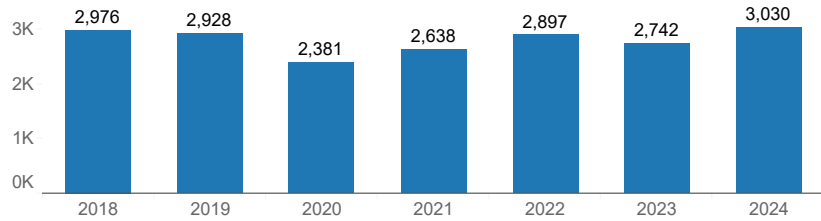

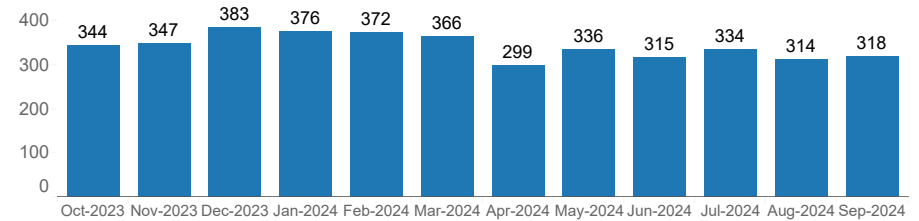

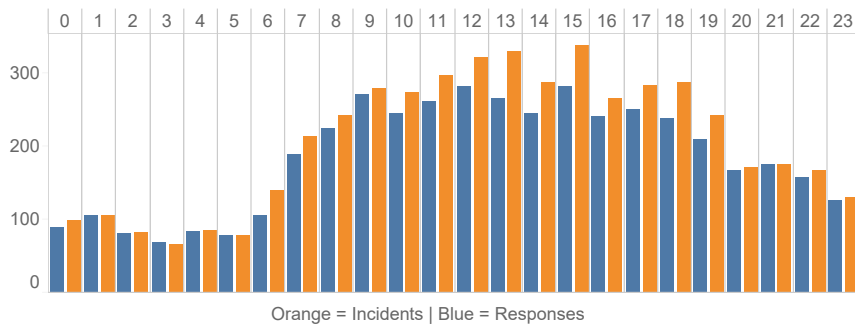
Incident Counts by Year (YTD)

Incident and Response Count by Hour of Day

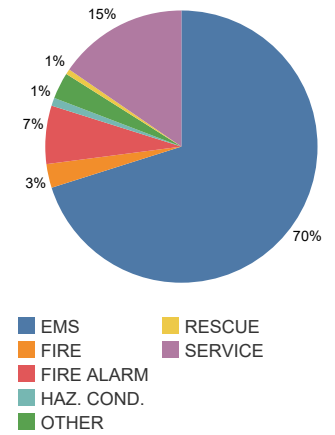
