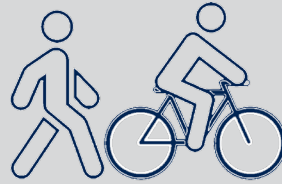

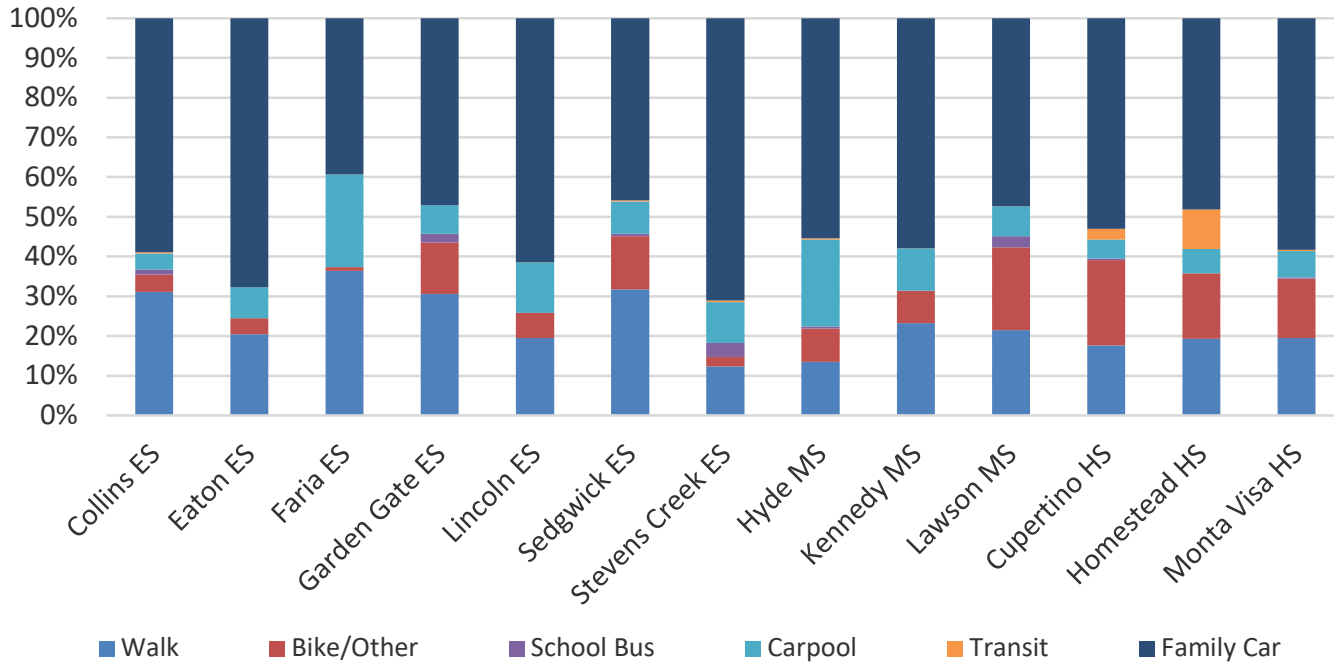
Fall 2024 Travel Modes

| Fall 2024 | Response Rate | Walk | Bike/Other | School Bus | Carpool | Transit | Family Vehicle | Alternative Travel |
|--------------------|---------------|------|------------|------------|---------|---------|----------------|--------------------|
| Elementary Schools | 88% | 26% | 6% | 1% | 12% | 0% | 56% | 44% |
| Middle Schools | 70% | 19% | 12% | 1% | 14% | 0% | 54% | 46% |
| High Schools | 32% | 19% | 18% | 0% | 6% | 3% | 54% | 46% |
| Citywide | 57% | 22% | 11% | 1% | 11% | 1% | 55% | 45% |

* Total alternative travel = all travel modes excluding family vehicle

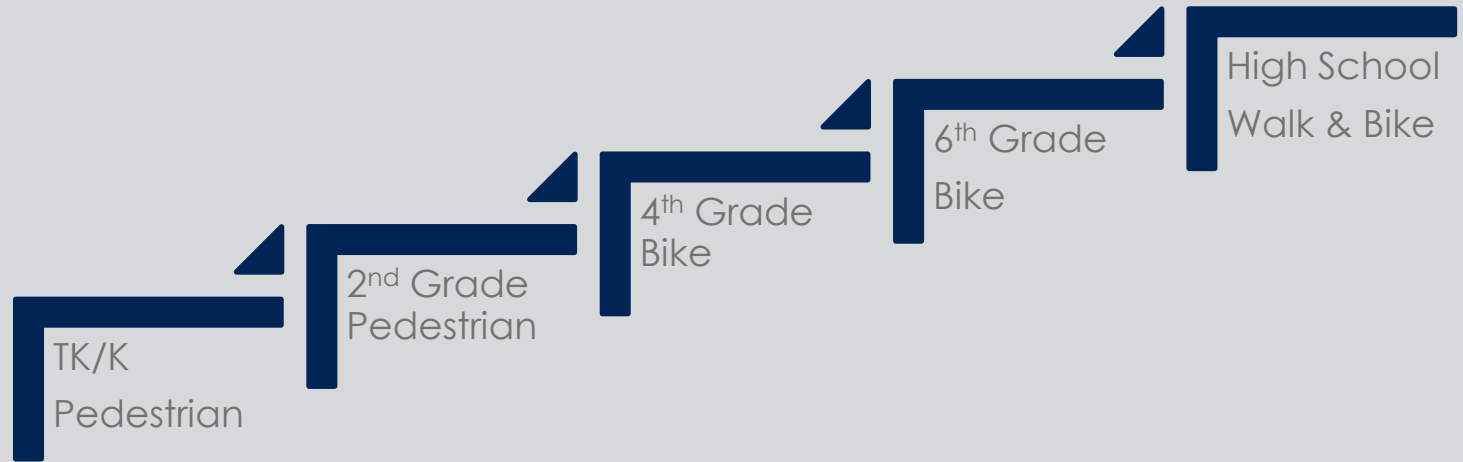

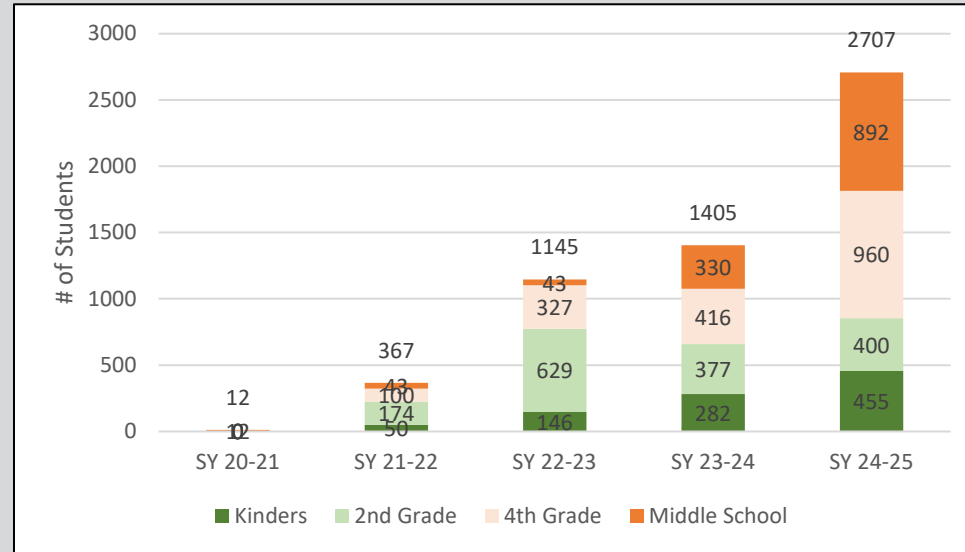


Traffic Safety Education Map



Number of Students who Received Traffic Safety Education each Year

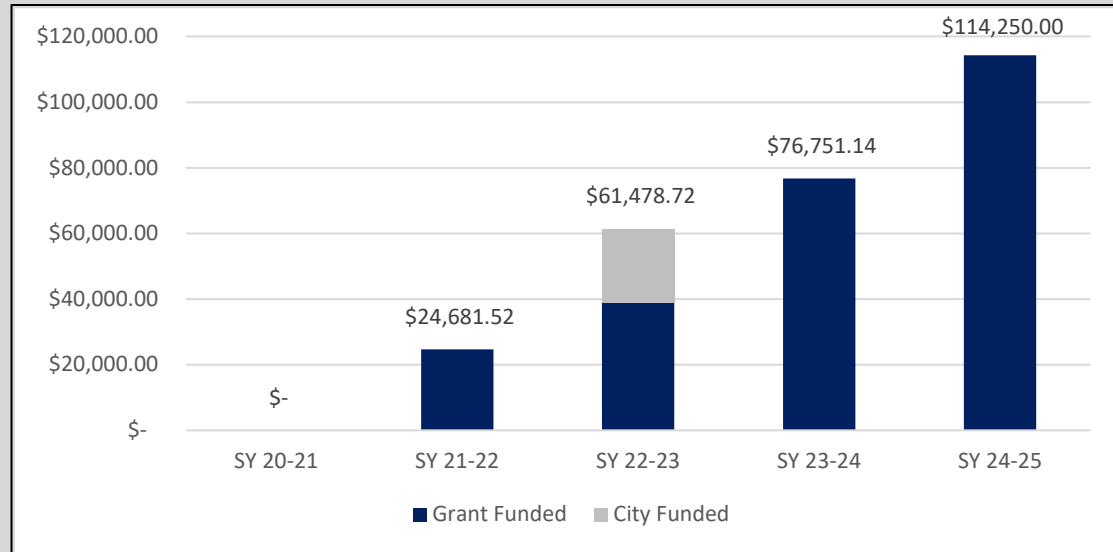





School Loop Waiting Areas




Legend:
Orange line: Inappropriate Waiting Area
Green line: Appropriate Waiting Area
Yellow bus icon: School Bus Waiting Area

1. Do not wait on Blaney to turn into the loop
2. Do not block the bike lane on Blaney to turn into the loop
3. Do not wait on Forest to access the loop

Pick-Up and Drop-Off Instructions

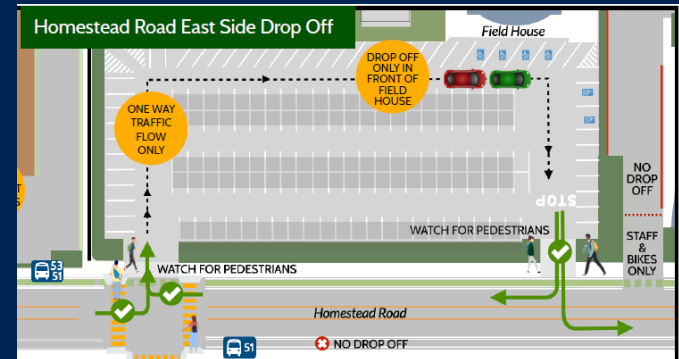
In order to keep all road users safe, do not impede traffic or car travel lanes while waiting to drop off or pick up your child. If the neighborhood is full, please do not wait in the middle of Blaney Avenue. In the neighborhood to wait, or circle around the block (all in to safely and completely enter the drop-off loop. Follow the route: (Blaney → Forrest → Plum Tree Lane → Merritt Dr → Blaney).

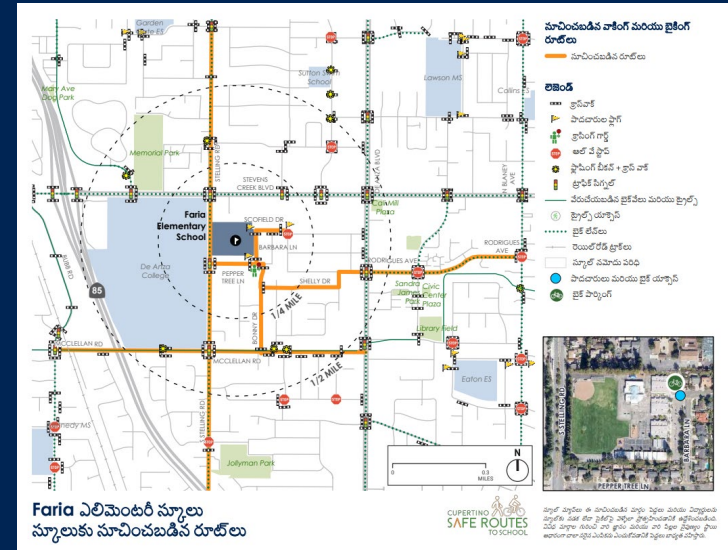
