WHEREAS, the 2018 UN Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) Report states that we have 12 years to make "massive and unprecedented changes" to global energy infrastructure to limit global warming to moderate levels; and

WHEREAS, the death and destruction already wrought by global warming of approximately 1°C demonstrate that the Earth is already too hot for safety as attested by increased and intensifying wildfires, floods, rising seas, diseases, droughts and extreme weather;

WHEREAS, immediate action must be taken to reduce greenhouse gas emissions;

WHEREAS, the State of California is a demonstrated leader in the fight against climate change; and

WHEREAS, the State Legislature passed the Buy Clean California Act (AB 262) in
