- WHEREAS,** The Taiwanese Cultural and Sports Association (TCSA), a non-profit organization established in 2010 by Dr. Hung and Dr. Anita, is dedicated to promoting Taiwanese culture and fostering intercultural exchange between Taiwan, the United States, and other nations;
- WHEREAS,** TCSA plays a vital role in encouraging young Taiwanese Americans to actively engage in cultural and athletic pursuits, thereby strengthening ties between the Taiwanese community and diverse cultural groups;
- WHEREAS,** TCSA organizes a wide range of events that promote cultural exchange, including festivals, educational programs, and volunteer-driven initiatives, fostering a deeper understanding of Taiwanese heritage;
- WHEREAS,** Since its inception in 2010, TCSA has successfully hosted the annual International Kids Fun Festival in Cupertino, with the exception of a two-year hiatus during the COVID-19 pandemic;
- WHEREAS,** The International Kids Fun Festival attracts over 20,000 attendees each year, featuring vibrant performances, Taiwanese cuisine, and cultural products, alongside booths representing more than 10 countries, all made possible through the dedication of performers, exhibitors, and over 300 volunteers; and
- WHEREAS,** The City of Cupertino is honored to have Memorial Park serve as the venue for TCSA's widely celebrated International Kids Fun Festival; and
- WHEREAS,** The 15th International Kids Fun Festival, scheduled for 2025 in Cupertino, will continue to bring joy and cultural enrichment to the community; and
