**A RESOLUTION OF THE CUPERTINO CITY COUNCIL
ADOPTING A COUNCIL POLICY ON DISRUPTION OF TELEPHONIC OR
INTERNET SERVICE DURING PUBLIC MEETINGS**

WHEREAS, on October 3, 2025, Governor Newsom signed into law Senate Bill 707 (SB 707), which amends the Brown Act to diversify and increase public engagement in meetings of local legislative bodies; and

WHEREAS, among other changes, SB 707 requires eligible legislative bodies, such as the City Council, to provide the public with a two-way phone and/or audiovisual platform; and

WHEREAS, SB 707 requires each eligible legislative body to adopt a written policy, on or before July 1, 2026, that establishes the procedure for recessing and reconvening a meeting in the event of disruption of remote participation, and the efforts that the eligible legislative body and staff shall make to attempt to restore the service; and

WHEREAS, the City Council currently holds its meetings in a hybrid format utilizing Zoom and will continue to do so.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council does hereby approve and adopt the Council Policy, "Disruption of Telephonic or Internet Service During Public Meetings," attached hereto as Exhibit A.
