




70% walking

Limit of Work

Concentrated to highopportunity, high-need areas of the site

Design

Focus on cost efficiency and meeting the community vision

- Balancing cut/fill of soil onsite to create a berm instead of a sound wall
- Reduced piping infrastructure







Design Development Plan: Planting



Design Development Plan: Active Recreation















- Quinlan Community Center
 - Cupertino Room capacity: 240 280
 - Social Room capacity: 80
 - Conference Room capacity: 20
- Creekside Park Building capacity: 50

What Facilities Do We Rent (continued)

- Senior Center
 - Reception Hall capacity: 160 200
 - Bay Room capacity: 40
 - Arts and Craft Room capacity: 40
 - Classroom capacity: 26
 - Conference Room capacity: 10
- Community Hall capacity: 152-170

Our highest priority is Cupertino

- Cupertino residents receive better rates than Non-Residents.
- Cupertino Non-Profits receive better rates than Non-resident Non-Profits.
