- I. Renewal document draft from TaiChung government. (Weini emailed it to you a couple of days ago.
- II. Summary of Friendship City / TaiChung delegation visits to Cupertino hosted by the Committee over the last two years:
 - a. TaiChung delegation and elementary school performance group of TaiChung government participated the “ Kids’N Fun festival “ in August, 2019. The CTFC (Cupertino-TaiChung Friendship Cities) had a tent to demonstrate TaiChung City’s culture, technology and food etc.
 - b. The baseball team of TaiChung DaRen Elementary School came to Bay Area to join little leagues event and played 6 games with local Bay Area baseball teams in July, 2019.
 - c. It’s the first time there were 4 students from TaiChung city came to Bay area for a 2 week summer camp program (July, 2019)
- III. Summary of Cupertino delegation visits hosted by the Friendship City:
 - a. Ten CTFC members visited TaiChung City and we really appreciated the warm welcome from Taichung government in November 2019.
 - b. In October, We hosted an Online Conference between Cupertino City and TaiChung City. There were 70 Senior High School participants.
- IV. Description of activities held and outcomes:
 - a. We did Market Stall activities three times in Creekside of Cupertino.
 - b. In April, we participated Cupertino “ Earth Day” event.
 - c. In July, we held the “ Health Fair “ event. It’s the biggest event in 2019. We have 16 doctors in the health fair event and over 800 Cupertino residents participated the event.
 - d. From June to August, the CTFC vice president Polly hosted Summer Line-dance program at the square of Cupertino City Hall.

In 2020, Due to the Covid-19 pandemic , we couldn’t get together the whole year, but we still continue having several Online meetings and services.

- e. In July, Vice Mayor Dr. Chou hosted a “ No Prop 16” Online Seminar for the Taiwanese members.
- f. In September, we hosted three events.
 - i. The CTFC co-sponsored for an Online meeting with Alzheimer’s Association.
 - ii. Hung Wei Council member hosted an Online “ Extravaganza Show “
 - iii. Our board directors served 130000 MIT Masks to the CTFC members.
- g. We donated 12000 MIT masks to Cupertino Library, Cupertino Post Office, Cupertino Fire department, Cupertino Senior center and Cupertino Rotary volunteer group.
- h. We have also donated 5000 MIT Masks to the Fremont Union High School District.
