

SAMPLE QUESTIONS FOR COMMISSION APPLICANTS

1. Tell us why you chose this Commission and how your background has supported this decision.
2. Commissions are generally advisory in nature. What does this mean to you?
3. Your role would be to represent the community over your personal preferences. How would you ensure you are connected to what the community wants?
4. Are you familiar with any guiding documents that the City has in place that set forth the goals for the subject of the Commission? If so, what?
5. How would you come up to speed with the topics the Commission concerns itself with?

City Committees and Commissions are subject to the Political Reform Act and members are required to submit Statements of Economic Interest upon appointment and annually thereafter.
