**A RESOLUTION OF THE CUPERTINO CITY COUNCIL  
APPROVING A BUDGET MODIFICATION AND AN INCREASE OF  
GRANT REVENUE ESTIMATES OF \$1,500,000 TO THE STEVENS CREEK
