To the City of Cupertino and to who it may concern,

We the people of Bianchi Way, Cupertino, object to having a three-story-building on our own street.

The density of the buildings is too great, and there is not enough street parking as it is now - even with expanding the street width, there will not be enough parking. Along with increased density comes increased conflicts.

This building will look down on others' bedrooms across the way which may violate people's privacy.

We already have a higher-than-normal traffic pattern on our little cul-de-sac, which would only get worse with this new building and will cause a lot of issues for those disabled residents who use the road.

Cupertino residents have already voted that there be a two-story limit on the height of buildings in Cupertino. We will hold the city of Cupertino liable for any damages, injuries, or deaths due to this higher density housing and higher-than-necessary traffic on this small dul-de-sac. We also will hold the property owner and any management company liable for any deaths injuries or damages.

Please reconsider this project – lowering the numbers units or the density or the height.



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Hi Planning Department and Planning Commission,

I attended and listened to Item #2 tonight regarding the Bianchi Way project and the struggles related to the disabled housing nearby. I am familiar with the disabled housing project and some of the struggles the residents endure. It took a lot for a person in a wheelchair to appear before you tonight!

I don't know what flexibility or influence you have BUT maybe

- Widen the sidewalk make it double the normal size all along Bianchi Way.
- Prioritize fixing the entire stretch of sidewalk on Bianchi Way over and above other sidewalk projects so the disabled are not forced to go on the street.
- Help the residents of the disabled housing project to request/obtain parking permits for all 6 street parking spaces or 4 of the 6 spaces. If they are forced to park elsewhere, it would be an enormous problem for people in wheelchairs. Much more so than a normal person, especially in that area of high traffic and no street parking.

Please step in now and help them. This is the ONLY disabled housing in Cupertino! They rely on being able to access Stevens Creek Blvd safely. (Seems to me like the health and safety of these special residents should have been considered a CEQA issue.)
