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Subject: CYFC 2019-2020 activities for Cupertino City review

For many years, Yilan is the home of "International Children's Folklore Festival" which is certified by UNESCO. (<http://www.visiontimes.com/2017/07/16/an-intriguing-childrens-folklore-festival-certified-by-unesco.html>).

Members from local communities formed CYFC in December 2016 to cultivate the cultural relationship between City of Cupertino and Yilan. CYFC intends to renew the friendship city status with City of Cupertino for 2021 and 2022.

Past two years activities and future plan for review:

A. Major 2019-2020 activities:

1. February 2019: CYFC hold a Yilan cultural food activity. We demonstrated the famous traditional technique to preserve Kamquat and other delicacies. Attendees learned Yilan techniques and received fruit kits.
2. February 2019: CYFC had an exhibit at Main Street Lunar New Year Festival to promote Yilan Culture. The festival was a big success with more the 4,000 visitors.
3. August 2019: CYFC provide two booths at annual Kids Fun Festival at Cupertino Memorial Park. We showcased Yilan artifacts and tourism attractions.
4. Dec 13 2019: Year-end Yilan HS and Cupertino HS video conference. LuoTong HS and Cupertino HS showcased robot design and performance at Community Room, Rainbow Library. The students demonstrated the robot design, motion, and organizational skills.

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5. February 2020: CYFC joined New Year Celebration at TECO Center. CYFC prepared Taiwanese red bean cake, stirred fry noodle in the event.
6. June 2020 Community service: Due to Flu Pandemic, most activities were suppressed. CYFC raised and distributed Taiwan medical grade face masks to community business entities and residents in Cupertino and near by cities.

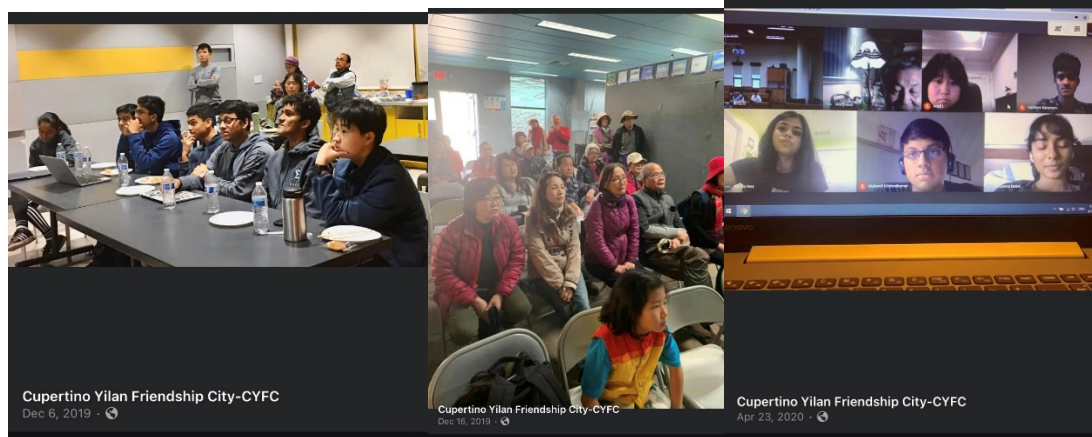

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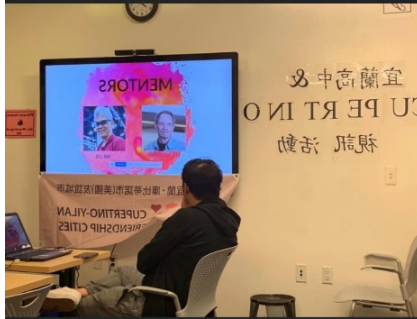

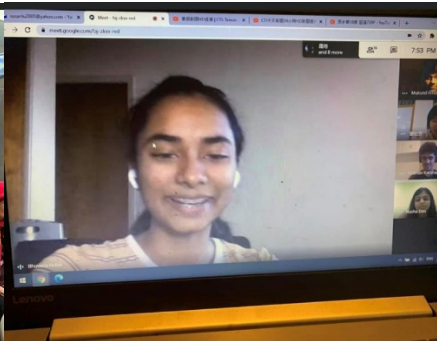
