**June 11, 2026.** Proposed Budget Format Discussion with Staff.

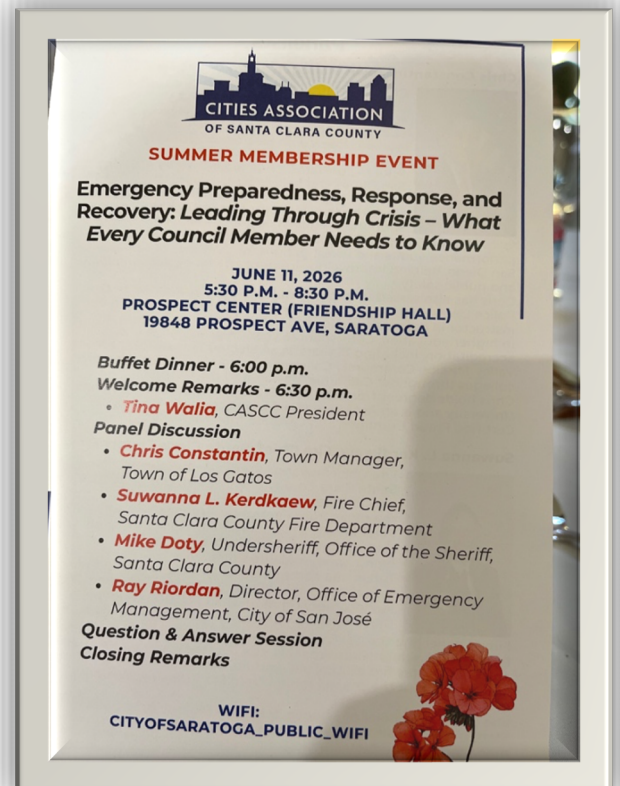
**June 11, 2026.** Cities Association of Santa Clara County Annual Summer Membership Event – Topic of discussion: When a disaster strikes.
