Subject

City of Cupertino's participation in the Santa Clara County Abandoned Vehicle Abatement Service Authority (AVASA).

Recommended Action

Adopt a resolution extending the participation of the City of Cupertino in the Santa Clara County Abandoned Vehicle Abatement Service Authority (AVASA).

Discussion

Since 1991, the City of Cupertino along with most of the cities within the County adopted and have continued to adopt resolutions that authorize participation in the AVASA program. The AVASA program provides State reimbursement for abandoned vehicle abatement services. During the period of fiscal year 2011 thru fiscal year 2020, the City of Cupertino was reimbursed \$321,661.34 for the removal of 1,450 abandoned or inoperative vehicles from both public and private property. This program has a ten-year life with a termination date of April 30, 2022. The AVASA Board has asked all participating cities to adopt the attached resolution authorizing continued participation for another ten-year term beginning May 1, 2022 by the end of September 2021.

Sustainability Impact

Fiscal Impact

Estimated reimbursement of approximately \$330,000 to the General Fund over the next ten years.
