Overview

- Includes Weed and Brush Abatement Programs
- Property owners must abate by noticed deadline
- Only noncompliant properties are assessed
- Hearing considers a resolution confirming assessments for unpaid fees
- Unpaid fees will appear on owner's property tax bill

Overview-Continued

- Owners may request Council remove their property from the assessment list
- Any waived fees will be billed to the City
- County charges include:
 - Contractor costs to remove weeds and brush
 - Inspection and administrative fees

Supplemental Process for Passed Inspections

- Applies to Weed Abatement Program
- Approved by Council on November 2, 2020
- Established ongoing \$8,886 budget appropriation (in General Fund)
- City covers costs for Initial Inspection Fee (\$92)
- Properties must pass inspection by April 30
- Letter mailed to property owners on December 13, 2022, for 2023 season

Assessment Report

July 6, County filed report with City

July 7, City mailed report/hearing notice to owners

Assessment Report (fail) – billed to homeowner	36 parcels	\$29,934
Passed initial inspection - for payment by City	81 parcels	\$7,452

Recommended Action:

- Conduct hearing to consider objections from property owners on the assessment report
- Adopt Resolution No. 23-093 approving lien assessment and collection of fees on private parcels
- 3. Approve budget appropriations of \$7,452 in the General Fund (to fund properties that passed the initial inspection)

Background - What is a Fee?

A fee or rate charged to an individual or group that receives a *private benefit* from services provided by the City.


Background - Fees for City Services

Fee Schedule	Description
Schedule A - General Fees	Miscellaneous fees not associated with one department (abatement fees, false alarms, PRA request, etc.)
Schedule B - Engineering Fees	Public Works – Engineering: Design and Inspection Services
Schedule C - Planning Fees	Community Development – Planning: Current, Mid, and Long-Term Planning
Schedule D - Building Fees	Community Development – Building: General Building, Construction Plan Check, and Building Code Enforcement
Schedule E - Parks & Recreation Fees	Parks & Recreation Services Fees are market driven
