- WHEREAS,** The City of Cupertino wishes to show its support for World Environment Day, which began in 1973, when the General Assembly of the United Nations urged members to undertake world-wide activities reaffirming their concern for the preservation and enhancement of the environment, with a commitment to deepening environmental awareness; and
- WHEREAS,** World Environment Day is now observed annually on June 5 throughout the world by governments and organizations in the United Nations system; and
- WHEREAS,** The Day helps the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) to raise awareness and generate political momentum around growing concerns, such as the depletion of the ozone layer, toxic chemicals, desertification and global warming; and
- WHEREAS,** The Day has developed into a global platform for taking action on urgent environmental issues; and
- WHEREAS,** The City recognizes the De Anza College Environmental Studies Department for its ongoing efforts to advance environmental education, sustainability, and community engagement in support of a healthier and more resilient future.
- THEREFORE,** I, Mayor Kitty Moore, and the Cupertino City Council do hereby Proclaim June 2, 2026 as
