Item Date, Title, and Description:

1/13/26 Accompanied by City staff, Councilmember Fruen and Commissioner Lindskog, I toured the **City Hall facility** in order to familiarize myself with the layout of the building and the physical condition of the structure.

1/14/26 I attended a meeting with the representative of **Dividend Homes** to review their proposed developments along Stevens Creek Blvd. A total of 89 units in 3- and 2-story buildings is being proposed. Council approved the plan at its January 21 meeting.

1/15/26 I participated in a Zoom session with City staff who made a presentation on the **Dividend Homes** projects and elaborated on the details, including density bonus waivers, conversations with the neighbors and limitations imposed by SB 330. This project will result in a net loss of units relative to the Housing Element. Staff will present solutions to Council at a later date.

1/19/26 Spoke to students of **Kennedy Middle School** about Council priorities and the ways young people can engage in civic discourse.

1/20/26 I attended a meeting with representatives of **Housing Choices**, an advocacy group for affordable housing for people with developmental disabilities. Their focus was on the Mary Ave project which will be discussed by Council at their February 3 meeting.

1/26/26 Celebrated **India's Republic Day** in San Francisco with India's Consul General and a large group of elected officials and community non-profits. Mayor

Daniel Lurie of San Francisco was the main speaker – he referenced the vital importance of the Constitution and the common values between India and the US.
