## A RESOLUTION OF THE CUPERTINO CITY COUNCIL APPROVING THE THIRD AMENDMENT TO THE EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF CUPERTINO AND CHRISTOPHER D. JENSEN, CITY ATTORNEY, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to increase the pay to the City Attorney to an annual base salary of \$310,500 effective December 3, 2024; and

WHEREAS, on January 1, 2026, the City Attorney's salary shall be increased by the same percentage and at the same time as any discretionary across-the-board increase in base annual compensation granted to exempt management employees covered by the Unrepresented Employees' Compensation Program; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to increase severance payment from three (3) months to nine (9) months aggregate salary and medical benefit allowance; and

WHEREAS, the terms, conditions and provisions of the Third Amendment to Employment Agreement have been reviewed and approved by the Senior Assistant City Attorney; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council does hereby approve the aforementioned Third Amendment to the Employment Agreement and authorizes the Mayor to execute said agreement on behalf of the City of Cupertino.
