- Staff review (not final)
 - 17 applicants fully met eligibility
 - 5 applicants pending eligibility
- Final eligibility to be determined by the Commission
- Commissioners to give a score of zero to applications they do not deem eligible
- Commission will review scores to discuss further

 - X/100
- Staff will compile Commissioner data
- Commission discussion
 - Review compiled data
 - Opportunity to adjust rankings
- Provide recommendation for City Council

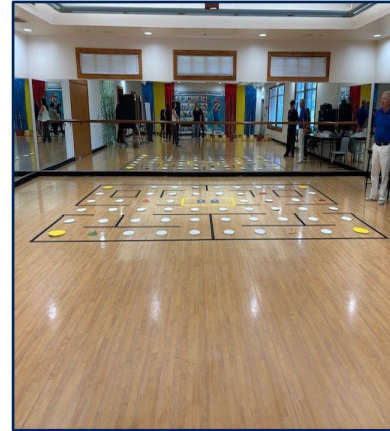

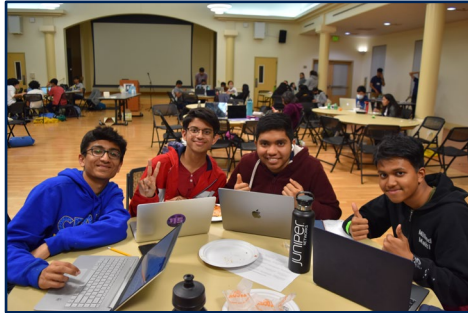
