Subject

Authorization of funding for the Sidewalk Renovation-Stevens Creek Blvd (Stelling-De Anza) Project in order to enhance accessibility in the public right of way.

Recommended Action

Authorize funding in the amount of \$250,000 for the Sidewalk Renovation-Stevens Creek Blvd (Stelling-De Anza) Project.

Description

The Sidewalk Renovation-Stevens Creek Blvd (Stelling-De Anza) Project will replace a portion of the existing pavers with concrete along Stevens Creek Boulevard between De Anza Boulevard and Stelling Road. The project will install approximately 1,700 linear feet of concrete walkway as well as perform some driveway repairs adjacent to the renovated sidewalk.

Background

In order to provide an enhanced level of public facilities, and in accordance with the Heart of the City Specific Plan, sections of the sidewalks along Stevens Creek Boulevard were initially constructed using pavers as opposed to standard concrete. To assist persons who prefer a smoother route, the City conferred with disabled persons, wheelchair users, and disability experts, among others, such that portions of the existing sidewalks have been identified to be retrofitted with a continuous concrete sidewalk pathway instead of pavers.

Discussion

By replacing some of the existing pavers with a continuous concrete sidewalk pathway, sidewalks along Stevens Creek Boulevard will not only retain some of the higher level finish that currently exists, but also provide a smoother route for those who prefer or may need such a pathway.

The total budget required to design and construct the changes is estimated to be \$250,000. Staff recommends appropriation of \$250,000 from Capital Reserves for the Sidewalk Renovation-Stevens Creek Blvd (Stelling-De Anza) Project.
