Artist Personal Statement

Dear Arts and Culture Commission,

As a current resident in Cupertino, I am honored to submit my work in Visual Arts for your consideration for the Distinguished Artist Award.

Over the last 30 years, I have created a substantial body of work that displays merit and excellence, and I have contributed to my artistic fields and the community, in France and in the United States.

Born and raised in France, I have been formally trained in Fine Arts schools in Paris, where I studied traditional drawing, painting, color, photography, calligraphy, typography, illustration and graphic design.

I started my career as an art director in advertising companies and as an instructor on digital art softwares. As an independent artist, I was also working for my community by creating Posters and collateral material for Cities and Theaters. I developed a personal style by mixing painting, photography, montages and typography, which brought me national press coverage and recognition in France.

An opportunity to design movie posters for Hollywood led me to relocate to California with an Artist of Extraordinary Ability visa (O-1). Through my agent, I free-lanced as an art director for many well established entertainment advertising agencies in Los Angeles. I contributed to creating Key Art for world-class projects such as "War of the Worlds", "The Aviator", and "No Country for Old Men", among many others.

At the same time, I opened my own boutique design studio, Purple Red, where I could provide art and design for independent film companies. I created movie posters for some historical and community oriented feature documentaries such as "The Chinese Exclusion Act" which has been broadcast on PBS, or "To Catch a Dollar" about Nobel Peace Prize Muhammad Yunus's loan system to help women in Queens NY. I provided art work for many smaller productions as well.

I also have operated as a still photographer on various movie sets, from short projects to feature films. My credits include "Strike One", a story about a young boy living in a gang-controlled place; "South of Pico", which won Best Picture at the American Black Film Festival; and "James Ellroy: American Dog", a documentary about (and with) the writer.

But I found my true voice as a photographer by working on personal photo projects, mostly focusing on portraits and equestrian photography. Some of my pictures have been published in equestrian magazines in the US and all the way to Australia.

Over the years, I've also been experimenting with music, video, ceramics, and sculpture.

But the medium I always go back to is painting. From my early years as a young art student in Paris, up to last week, painting wins my heart over and over again. My style evolved over time and went from figurative to abstract, and now back to figurative with a lot of abstract textures and layers in it. My most recent painting will include an installation on its side and augmented reality content, as a way to explore a deeper way to tell a story, and to connect timeless medium with modern technologies.

I'm currently working on a series of paintings about horses, which have been used - and too often abused - by humans for centuries. They are incredibly beautiful and sensitive creatures who suffer in silence. Through this work, one can perceive a story that can be related to other minorities who never had a voice. I am subtly exploring the ideas of freedom, freewill, connection with nature, and partnership. I aim to offer a beautiful and powerful visual, rich in textures and layers, as I choose to inspire and heal rather than denounce.

When I relocated to Cupertino about four years ago, I enrolled in Foothill/De Anza college. Last June I graduated with an Associate in Art degree in Studio Arts with a 4.0 GPA, which earned me the Foothill President's medal.

I am currently enrolled for the Fall quarter at UCSC as a transfer student. My goal is to major in Art, and to embrace opportunities to try new ideas, especially in the field of painting, photography, and environmental art.

I also hope to gain more visibility as an artist, so that I can reach more people and share that we, humans, have the amazing gift to be able to create art. Through art, we can tell underlying stories that help rewrite what history often tries to hide. And through art education, we can remind ourselves to embrace beauty and perceive the world as a work of art as well.

Art is enjoyable, inspiring, and a way to connect to the essence of mankind.

In this digital time and age, I find a lot of joy working with techniques that have been around for centuries. Those include the charcoal, that little piece of burned wood our ancestors used to draw with in the caves! It's absolutely magical, and so versatile...and leaving a mark on a wall is as a way to honor our presence on this planet. I'd love to do public demonstrations and help promote the arts in the community.





Personal Statement - Eva Olsen

My name is Eva Olsen, artist and educator based in Cupertino, California. I earned my BFA in Art and Design from California Polytechnic State University, San Luis Obispo, with a concentration in studio art.

I have worked in Cupertino for four years at Hongyun Art, the last two as studio manager, focusing on managing operations and communication, and helping students develop their AP Art and college portfolios. I feel immensely privileged and inspired to be able to work with students in Cupertino who are creative, driven individuals. My goals as studio manager at Hongyun Art are to first, cultivate an artistic space for our students to be able to authentically express themselves, and for them to connect with each other and our community. I am very proud of our students' achievements, and they've been recognized in various local and national art exhibitions and awards, such as New Museum of Los Gatos ArtNOW Exhibition, Scholastic Art and Writing, the Cupertino Emerging Arts and Young Art Competition, and San Jose Museum of Art's Dr. Jerry Hiura Next Gen Visual artist award. As an educator and artist, I encourage my students to build self-confidence and share their work. The process of sharing and submitting is a big milestone for the students, and I am glad that I get to be a mentor for their experiences.

In my personal art practice, I engage in a dialogue with my past work, primarily exploring the aftermath of disaster, as well as themes of cellular and organic growth in diverse settings. My drawings and paintings often reference the human body, the natural world, and remnants of digital culture, employing bright, saturated colors and visible markmaking as prominent technical features. I have been exploring utilizing more recognizable symbols as a way to connect and communicate my themes to audiences without as much art background.

My goals as an artist are to keep sharing visual art and working on helping others develop their art within our community - both for my peers, students at Hongyun Art and within the greater Cupertino area.










Personal statement

As an art teacher deeply committed to both my craft and the enrichment of my community, I'm honored to apply for the Cupertino Distinguished Artist Award. My artistic path has been a journey of exploration, growth, and a passion for fostering creativity in individuals of all ages.

My artistic promise lies in my unwavering commitment to pushing the boundaries of creativity and my dedication to making art accessible to everyone. Starting from my first observational artwork completed at the age of one, I've never stopped on this path of art. During high school, I made a firm decision to pursue further education in a pure fine arts school, embarking on a different path from others. 
Kathy started with the 2022 summer classes, but seeing our interest and keenness to learn more, she now has been teaching us regularly for over a year, and still



I soon found myself creating age appropriate art to bring to elementary age students as part of the substitute day. Their enthusiasm for art sparked a desire to bring well planned, easy-to succeed, art projects to hundreds of children over my 15 years of classroom teaching in several of the CUSD elementary schools. In addition, I have participated in the art docent program as well as the annual Reflections Art Program as a judge in the visual arts category.

I was awarded the CA State PTA Honorary service award in 2004 for my years of supporting CUSD school, Stocklmeir Elementary. I volunteered as a Great Books discussion leader, Art Docent, and manager of the Scrip Fundraiser program. In addition, provided classroom support as room parent when my kids attended the school. I participated in set design and musical accompaniment for various plays and productions in the district.

I currently hold an ECE Site Supervisor permit and work at De Anza College CDC as an administrator/teacher for young children, ages 2-5 yrs. The CDC follows the pedagogy of child directed learning to encourage creativity and higher level thinking in young children.

I have an online art group through the NextDoor App entitled "Summer Friendship Paint Group" where like-minded neighbors can share their art and I provide tips and advice, as well as my own art. From that group, sprung an in-person class with adults learning in depth painting techniques in weekly painting sessions in my garage. 





Mukund is first and foremost a very capable director. He is very versatile across genres. 


