Re: Removal of On-Street Parking- McClellan Road and Pacifica Drive

Dear Cupertino Resident:

The McClellan Road Separated Bikeways Project is a multi-phase project that will install separated bike lanes on McClellan Road and Pacifica Drive between Byrne Avenue and Torre Avenue. The Public Works Department is moving forward with the second phase of the project, which will construct an on-street bike lane and physical separation between motor vehicles and bicycles on McClellan Road between Stelling Road and De Anza Blvd, and along Pacifica Drive between De Anza Blvd and Torre Ave. . At this time, construction is anticipated to begin in early August. The construction duration is about 3 months.

As a result of the project, **on-street parking will be permanently removed along both sides of McClellan Road and Pacifica Drive between Stelling Road and Torre Avenue.** Staff anticipates conducting the first reading of the ordinance to prohibit parking at the Cupertino City Council meeting on July 21, 2020. The parking prohibition would become effective upon the second reading of the ordinance, tentatively scheduled for the August 18, 2020 City Council meeting
