Item Date, Title, and Description:

01/14/25      Attended a prep session organized by city staff to provide updates on **development projects**, such as Scofield Drive, Vista Heights, Evulich Ct. Planning and CDD staff also provided information on the consequences of redoing or downzoning the HCD-certified Housing Element.

01/16/25      Attended the installation ceremony for the **Chamber of Commerce** Board of Directors, and spent some time acknowledging and appreciating the good work that the Chamber does in attracting new businesses and partnering with the City at major events.

1/17/25      At a prep session, staff presented and discussed the City's next **City Work Program**. At this meeting items selected by the Council were listed and staff explained the methodology for calculating resources for each project. The CWP appeared on the 1/22/25 agenda for initial discussion.

1/23/25      Attended the JPA board meeting of the **Santa Clara County Library District**. Staff provided a recap of the past year's accomplishments, including the opening of the Women's library at the Elmwood Correctional Campus, facility improvements at libraries in Gilroy, Milpitas and Los Altos. Technology is also being upgraded at all libraries with newer models of computers being installed. Silicon Valley Reads, an annual feature of the County Library District, will kick off this week.

1/26/25      I was honored to attend the celebration of **India's 76<sup>th</sup> Republic Day** at the Indian Community Center in Milpitas. Along with several elected officials,

including Mayor Chau, I made brief comments about diversity in Cupertino and encouraged the audience to come to our city to play, dine, and walk our trails. Also, present were Congressman Ro Khanna, and State assembly leaders such as Alex Lee and Ash Kalra.
