- Support Cupertino Biking Events
 - April: Earth Day/ Pedal for the Planet—lead rides, promote event, support event
 - July: Bike to Work Day—plan and run Energizer Station
 - October: Fall Bike Fest—lead rides, promote event, support event
- 2016 Bicycle Transportation Plan and 2018 Pedestrian Transportation Plan
 - Review designs and progress on projects with City Staff as they are implemented and discuss potential resolution for issues
 - Support Bike/Pedestrian Plan projects through:
 - community outreach, including social media
 - active and vocal support to City Council
 - seeking support from advocacy groups (Walk-Bike Cupertino, Silicon Valley Bike Coalition, Western Wheelers, etc)
 - Participate in Workshops, Rides, Public Meetings and other events where bike/ped projects are discussed
- Represent Cupertino on the VTA BPAC
- Advocate for improved biking and walking in Cupertino
 - Support the efforts of Safe Routes to School and encourage positive changes to improve safety for commuting students around schools
 - Provide active and vocal support of increased bike racks and/or bike lockers (per code) and improved street infrastructure on future projects in the development planning cycle
 - Support increased biking education for all ages
 - Promote facilities for improved biking to work
- Analyze impact of biking/walking infrastructure changes as they occur
- Review BPC webpage and City of Cupertino Transportation bike/ped project webpages to determine if content can be updated to enhance understanding of how projects meet the goals of the Bicycle and Pedestrian Plans.
