# McClellan Road Sidewalk Improvements – Phase 2

*Byrne Avenue to San Leandro Avenue*

## **Project Description**

Work includes the addition of sidewalk, curb, and gutter where gaps currently exist as well as drainage improvements and planting strips where possible. Within the project limits, improvements are concentrated from Byrne Avenue to Madrid Road and Mira Vista Road to San Leandro Avenue.

## **Benefits**

The project will enhance pedestrian safety by providing continuous walking paths within the project area. Additionally, new curb and gutter will better control the flow of storm water.

## **Schedule**

Construction on the project began in September of 2018 and will be substantially complete by late November.

## **Funding**

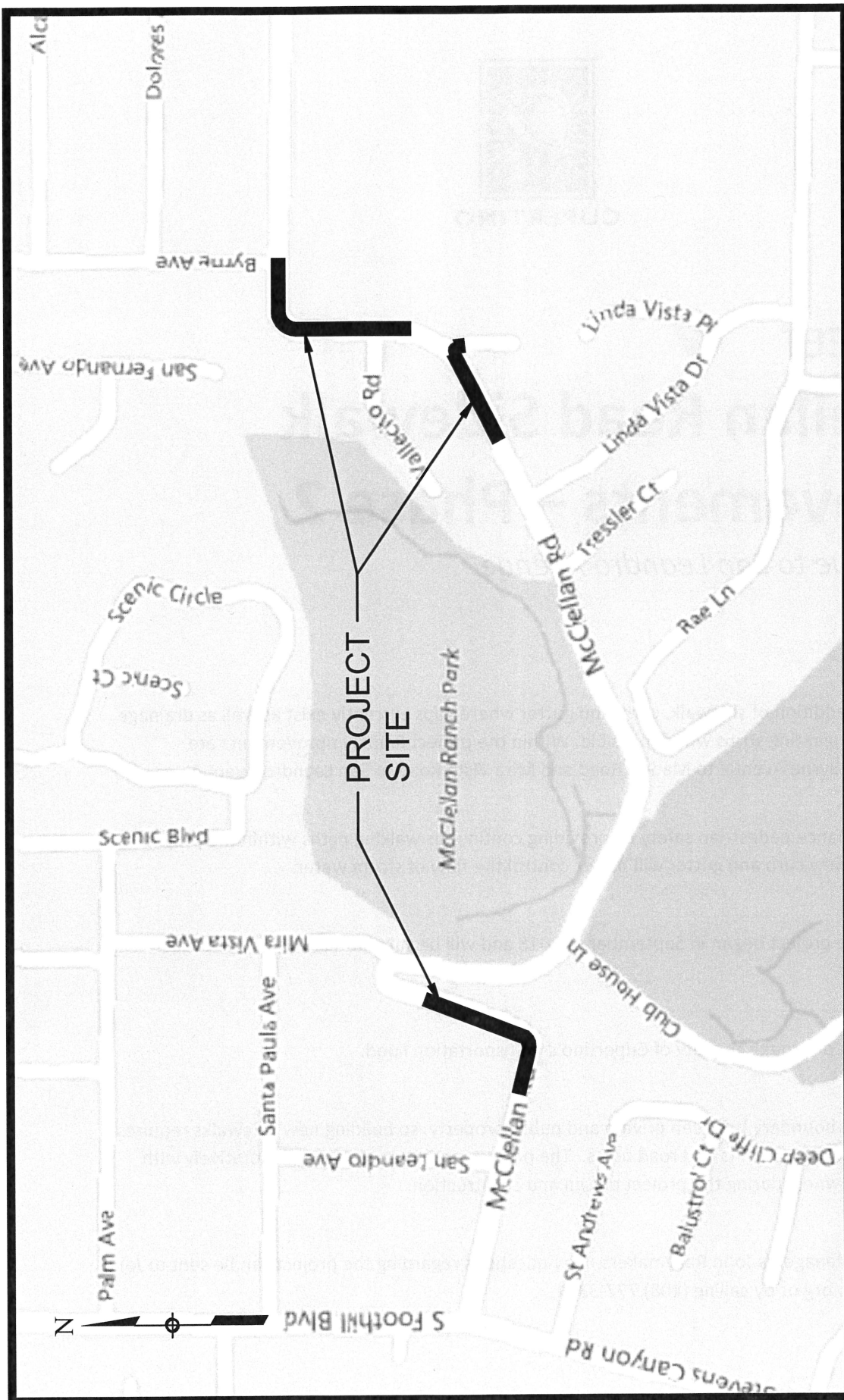
This project is funded through the City of Cupertino's Transportation Fund.

## **Outreach**

Sidewalks mark the boundary between private and public property, so building new sidewalks requires close coordination with residents and road users. The project team has worked collaboratively with affected property owners during the project design and construction.
