4. Incident Counts by Year (YTD): This bar chart shows the total of all code two and three calls for the last four years, from January 1 to last month's end, for each year.

5. Dollar Loss by Year (YTD): This bar chart shows the total of all dollar losses for the last four years, from January 1 to last month's end, for each year.

6. Community Education Events (Last Month): This table shows the total number of events, personnel, and attendees at educational events.

7. Incident Types (Last Month): This pie chart provides a breakdown of the number of calls by incident category.

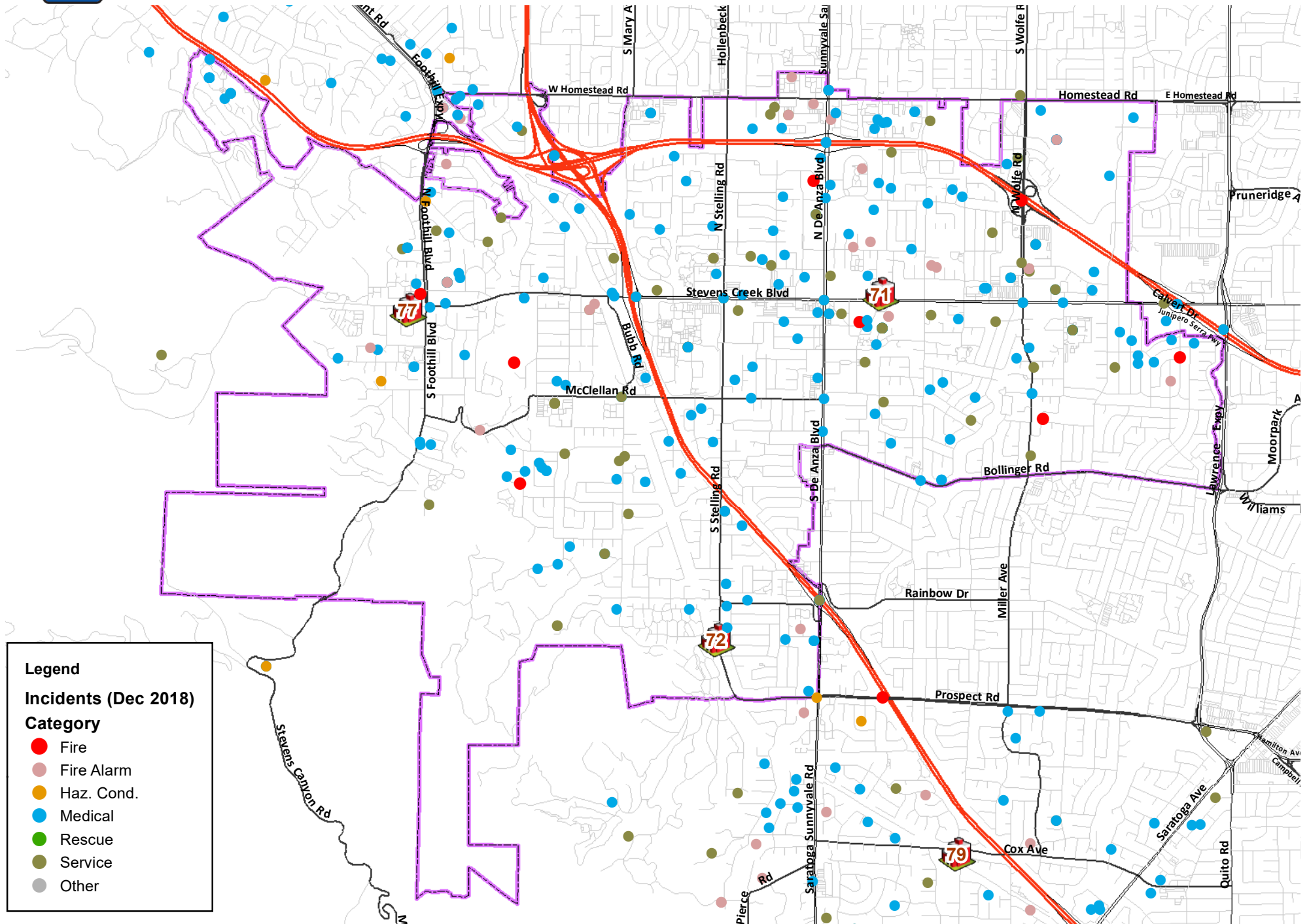

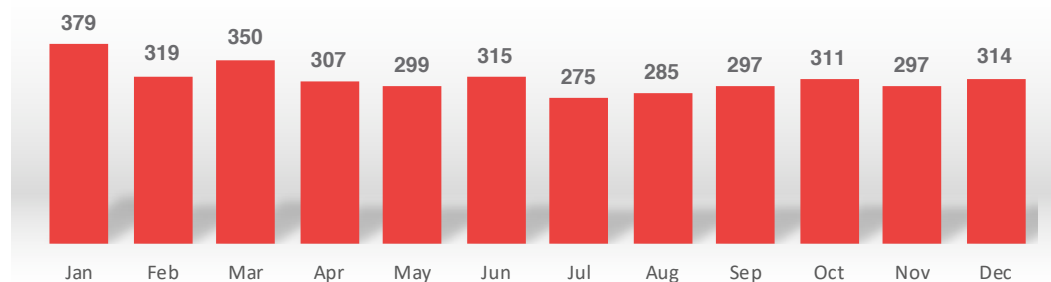

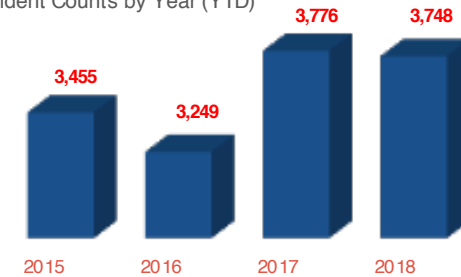

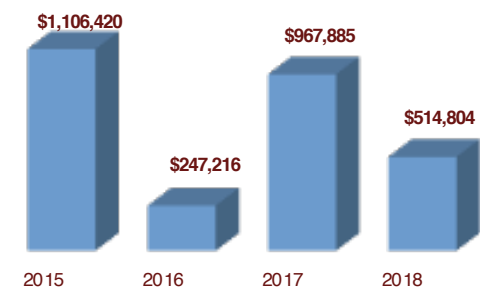
3) Incident Counts by Month (2018)



4) Incident Counts by Year (YTD)



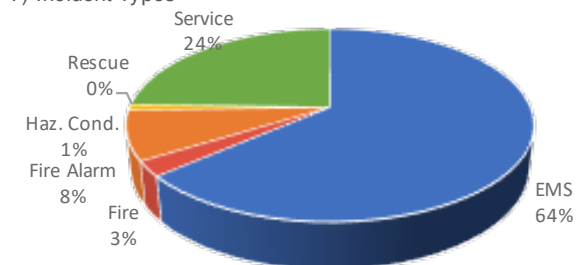
