CDBG Program

The United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) annually allocates entitlement grants to local jurisdictions for community development activities. Jurisdictions typically must have a population of 50,000 or more to qualify. This the City's seventeenth year as an entitlement jurisdiction receiving a CDBG grant directly from HUD.

CDBG Required Plans

 <u>Consolidated Plan</u> – Five year planning document that identifies local community development needs and sets forth a strategy to address those needs utilizing federal CDBG funds. 2015-2020 Consolidated Plan approved on April 7, 2015.

CDBG Required Plans

cont...

2. <u>Annual Action Plan</u> – One year planning document covering the upcoming FY 2019-20 that describes the eligible activities that the City intends to undertake to address the needs identified in the Consolidated Plan.

Due annually to HUD by August 16th.

CDBG Required Plans cont...

3. <u>Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation</u> <u>Report (CAPER)</u>– One year planning document that reports accomplishments of the prior FY 2018-19 that were outlined in the Consolidated Plan and Annual Action Plan.

Due annually to HUD by September 30th.
