Community Gardens Update

August 1, 2019



Community Garden Timeline

- **FY 18-19** Garden project funded for 1.5 million
- **October, 2018** – Gardens close, current site cleared, new design created
- **2019** – City Council removes funding for gardens
- **May, 2019** – City Council puts gardens back on to the funded list of projects with a smaller budget, request to incorporate volunteer efforts, and look at satellite garden options

Current Considerations

- Divide the project in to two phases, deferring the development of 32 garden plots
- Reduce the size of the large plots from 500 to 300 sq. ft.
 - Old Garden 59 plots
 - New Plan 79 plots
 - Revised $80 + 32 = 112$ plots
- Fewer water sources
- Eliminate raised beds and utilize volunteer construction

Current Status

- Finalize revision
- August bid with Fall construction
- Investigate satellite garden options

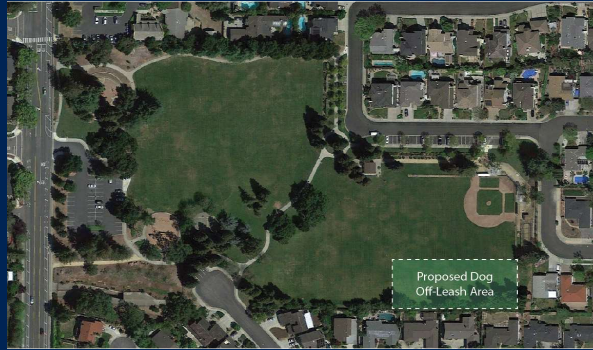

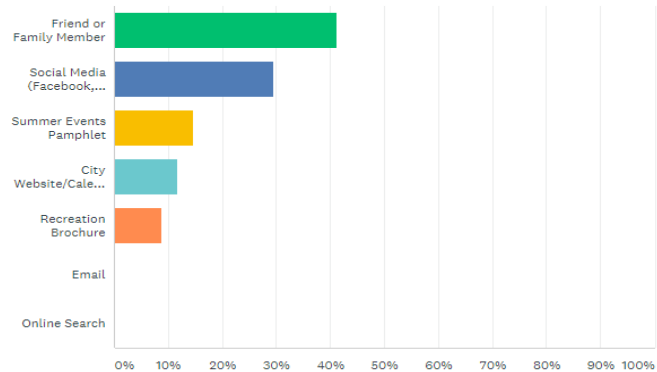
- 34 Total Responses
