Discussion

On July 25, 2022, the Audit Committee reviewed the Accounts Payable registers as part of the Monthly Treasurer's Report for June 2022. This supplemental staff report provides responses to the Audit Committee's inquiries.

Responses to Audit Committee's Inquiries

#34625, 6/24/2022, West Valley Community Svcs Agency, \$60,756.86

The payment included \$7,277.64 for the Homeless Jobs Program, a pilot job training program, and \$53,479.22 in operating and personnel expenses for the Vista Village Renovation Project. The Vista Village Renovation Project costs are CDBG grant expenditures.

#730573, 7/1/2022, County of Santa Clara, \$18,109.67

The payment was for supplemental law enforcement services on behalf of the Apple Worldwide Developers Conference. The City coordinates billing for supplemental law enforcement services. It is pass-through revenue with a 15% administrative fee for the City.

#730582, 7/1/2022, Fremont Union High School District, \$40,575.00

The payment was for the Summer Intensive Geometry (SIG) program, which had 88 participants. This payment is the closing payment to the consultant.

#730612, 7/1/2022, Applied Development Economics, \$18,600.00

The payment was for professional services for Economic Development strategy data. The Economic Development Manager manages the project and confirms they are tracking expenses against the total approved amount of \$30,000. There is one more invoice to submit to Finance.
