Subject: 6-Month Pilot Program to Allow Recology to Collect Garbage, Recyclables and Organic Containers at 6:00 A.M. Beginning the Week of February 23, 2015

City of Cupertino Resident,

An application for a special exception to the City of Cupertino Municipal Code Chapter 10.48 Community Noise Control has been completed by the Public Works Department. **If granted, Recology will begin the collection of garbage, recyclables and organic containers as early as 6:00 A.M. on your current collection day. Please have your carts out prior to 6:00 A.M. on your collection day during this pilot program.**

As shown on the map on the back of this notice, streets selected for early collection are heavily traveled by pedestrians, cyclists and vehicles accessing and exiting Kennedy Middle School, Lincoln Elementary School and Monta Vista High School. **The purpose of the 6:00 A.M. start is to allow residents to retrieve their containers from the street as early as 7:15 A.M.** Removal of containers prior to the start of school will allow cyclists to travel in the bike lane without these potential obstructions.

The 6:00 A.M. collection of garbage, recycling and organic containers is scheduled to occur on your normal collection day the week of February 23, 2015. A door knob hanger will be delivered to your home one week prior to remind you of the change and to encourage you to collect your containers by 7:15 A.M. on your collection day.

The City may consider a permanent change to an early collection time pending the comments received from this notice and if implemented, evaluation of the pilot program effectiveness. If this occurs, additional notification and opportunity for public comment will occur.
