CITY COUNCIL STAFF REPORT

Meeting: January 15, 2019

<u>Subject</u>

Introduction of an ordinance to amend regulations in Title 2, Administration and Personnel of the Municipal Code Chapter 2.80, to allow up to five (5) members for the Fine Arts Commission.

Recommended Actions

Conduct the first reading of the Draft Ordinance: "An Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Cupertino amending regulations in Title 2, Administration and Personnel of the Municipal Code, Chapter 2.80, to allow up to five (5) members for the Fine Arts Commission" and schedule second reading for February 5, 2019 to enact said ordinance.

Discussion

On February 6, 2018, the City Council introduced and conducted the first reading of Ordinance 18-2171 to amend regulations in Title 2, Administration and Personnel of the Municipal Code, Chapter 2.80, to allow up to six (6) members for the Fine Arts Commission, which took effect on March 22, 2018, 30 days after the second reading. The City Council also directed staff to amend the ordinance back to five (5) members to reflect that, as of January 31, 2019 when the next Fine Arts Commissioner term expires, the City Council does not need to fill another sixth seat. This item is a follow up on that direction. On December 11, 2018, the Fine Arts Commission reviewed the draft amendments to Municipal Code Chapter 2.80 and support the provision of up to five (5) members with no other comments.
