A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CUPERTINO ACCEPTING THE CITY OF CUPERTINO STORM DRAIN MASTER PLAN DATED SEPTEMBER 2018

WHEREAS, the City of Cupertino operates and maintains a storm drain system that serves the City of Cupertino; and

WHEREAS, upgrades to the storm drain system are necessary to alleviate localized flooding and ongoing operational and maintenance needs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cupertino has utilized recommendations set forth by the City of Cupertino Storm Drainage System Master Plan, dated March 1993; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to update the Storm Drain Master Plan in order to take into account improvements made to the system since acceptance of the City of Cupertino Storm Drainage System Master Plan, dated March 1993, and to incorporate more advanced software in the preparation of the hydraulic models; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cupertino retained Schaff & Wheeler Consulting Civil Engineers, a registered professional engineer certified by the State of California, to prepare the City of Cupertino Storm Drain Master Plan, dated September 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Storm Drain Master Plan, prepared by Schaaf & Wheeler Consulting Civil Engineers, describes and prioritizes capital improvement projects necessary to maintain and improve the storm drain collection system operated by the City in a manner consistent with industry standards;

WHEREAS, acceptance of the Storm Drain Master Plan is statutorily exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15262 of the Guidelines for CEQA.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Cupertino accepts the Storm Drain Master Plan, dated September 2018, attached hereto.
