## A RESOLUTION OF THE CUPERTINO CITY COUNCIL RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 20-014 THEREBY REMOVING THE DESIGNATION OF THE CITY MANAGER AS THE CITY EMPLOYEE/OFFICER TO ATTEND CITY COUNCIL CLOSED SESSIONS AND KEEP MINUTES AND CONFIRMING THE CITY CLERK AS THE DESIGNATED EMPLOYEE/OFFICER TO ATTEND CITY COUNCIL CLOSED SESSIONS AND KEEP MINUTES

WHEREAS, The Brown Act, contained in California Government Code Section 54950 et seq., authorizes a City Council to go into closed session to discuss certain sensitive matters, including personnel, salary negotiations, real property transactions, and litigation; and

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 54957.2 authorizes a City Council by resolution or ordinance to designate an employee or official to attend closed sessions and keep a record of the topics discussed and decisions made in closed session; and

WHEREAS, The City Council passed and adopted Resolution No. 20-014 at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Cupertino on February 4, 2020 designating the City Manager as the City Employee/Officer to attend City Council closed sessions and keep minutes.

WHEREAS, The City Council wishes to rescind Resolution No. 20-014 (Attachment A), thereby removing the designation of the City Manager as the City Employee/Officer to keep closed session minutes and confirming the City Clerk as the City Employee/Officer to attend City Council closed sessions and keep minutes as provided in Municipal Code Section 2.20.010.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council does hereby rescind Resolution No. 20-014.
