WHEREAS, on February 7, 2023, the Cupertino City Council held a public hearing and at the conclusion of the hearing upheld the appeal in part, approved one of the two requested freeway-oriented signs, and denied the requested sign exception on a 4-1 vote (Moore voting no) for application EXC-2022-003; and

- 1. Petitioner did not provide new relevant evidence which, in the exercise of reasonable diligence, could not have been produced at any earlier city hearing (Municipal Code § 2.08.096(B)(1)).
- 2. Petitioner failed to demonstrate that relevant evidence was improperly excluded at any prior City hearing (Municipal Code § 2.08.096(B)(2)).
