**A RESOLUTION OF THE CUPERTINO CITY COUNCIL  
RESCINDING THE PROCLAMATION OF EXISTENCE OF A LOCAL  
EMERGENCY**

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WHEREAS, the Emergency Services Act, Government Code section 8630 *et seq.*, and section 2.40.060 of the Cupertino Municipal Code empower the Director of Emergency Services (City Manager or Designee) to proclaim the existence or threatened existence of a local emergency if the Council of the City of Cupertino ("City") is not in session, and require that the City Council shall take action to ratify the proclamation within seven (7) days thereafter, or the proclamation shall have no further force or effect; and

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2020, the Director of Emergency Services issued a proclamation declaring the existence of a local emergency within the City; and

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2020, the City Council of Cupertino ratified and confirmed the proclamation declaring the existence of a local emergency within the City; and

WHEREAS, on February 28, 2023, the State of California's proclamation of emergency for COVID-19 expired; and

WHEREAS, In light of the current state of the pandemic, the status of the City's pandemic response, the availability of vaccines and treatments, and the current public health indicators, it is appropriate to terminate the Proclamation of Local Emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

1. The Proclamation of Existence of a Local Emergency issued on March 11, 2020, is hereby terminated.
2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
