Event Date, Title, and Description:

Event 1. 3/31/2023 - CHEFS OF COMPASSION. This annual fundraiser to benefit West Valley Community Services has returned to its in-person form, this time hosted at the Computer History Museum in Mountain View. The event was sold out and resulted in tens of thousands of donation commitments to WVCS.

Event 2. 4/1/2024 - SAN JOSE HOLI FESTIVAL. This year's festival of colors occurred at History Park in San Jose and was organized by WomenNowSV. I attended along with Assemblymember Ash Kalra, San Jose Mayor Matt Mahan, our own Mayor Hung Wei, and Saratoga Vice-Mayor Yan Zhao.

Event 3. 4/2/2024 – CUPERTINO HOLI FESTIVAL. The Chamber of Commerce put on its annual and widely attended festival of colors in Memorial Park on the field behind the Quinlan Center. Despite the colder weather, revelers clearly enjoyed themselves and covering each other in color.
