Event 1. 4/27/23 - HOMELESSNESS PREVENTION SYSTEM COMMUNITY BRIEFING - I attended a briefing on Destination: Home's homelessness prevention efforts. The meeting was well-attended by a variety of local electeds and specifically featured Destination: Home's partnerships with local agencies and other non-profits in the County.
