Commercial Service Cost Comparison to Similar Agencies

**Per the Franchise Agreement – An existing customer's rates cannot be increased due to additional bins or service needed to separate organic waste, over the rate the customer is currently paying for garbage service. This is intended to prevent additional cost to the customer when they begin separating organic waste rather than disposing of it as garbage. New businesses pay the full cost for each additional bin. They have an opportunity to use smaller 32 and 64-gallon carts to keep their costs as low as possible. As a Zero Waste goal, businesses are encouraged to recycle to the maximum extent possible and limit their garbage to an amount that can be contained in smaller carts.
