NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING: PROPOSED COMMERCIAL WASTE DISPOSAL RATE INCREASE

At the Council meeting on July 5, 2016, at 6:45 p.m. the Cupertino City Council will conduct a public hearing on proposed increases to commercial solid waste disposal rates of no more than 5.28%.

Reason for the Proposed Increase

The City of Cupertino contracts with Recology South Bay to provide solid waste disposal, recycling and organic processing services. State and local mandates designed to extend the use and capacity of landfills and reduce negative environmental impacts affect the cost of providing these services. The proposed commercial solid waste disposal rate increase is needed to cover increased cost of processing organic materials collected at commercial businesses and multi-family developments. Organic material includes food and landscape waste. **On July 1, 2018**, commercial and multi-family properties that generate 4 cubic yards or more of solid waste per week will be required to subscribe to organic waste collection service.

If you wish to comment on the proposed commercial solid waste disposal rate increase for consideration by the City Council on Tuesday, July 5th, you may attend the City Council meeting at 6:45 p.m. on 7/5/16 and speak during the public hearing when the item is called. You may also submit *written* comments to the Office of the City Clerk in the form of a letter, fax, or e-mail. Written comments for consideration at the meeting must be received by 5:00 p.m. on July 5, 2016.
