Dear Public Information Officer Kitson,

AT&T's contracts with programmers for the content displayed on U-verse TV® service periodically expire, or may be terminated, but are usually re-negotiated or extended with no interruption or change for our U-verse members. Additionally, from time to time it is necessary to change channel line-ups as well as television package contents. The programming changes set forth below may occur as follows:

March 2017:

Effective March 17, 2017, One World Sports (channel 1665) renamed to Eleven Sports Network.

Effective March 17, 2017, ShortsHD (channel 1789 in HD) renamed to ShortsTV.

Effective March 20, 2017, NBC Universo (channels 192, 193, 3009, 3010) renamed to NBC UNIVERSO.

April 2017:

The following channels renamed in April:

- 1) Comcast SportsNet California (channel 767 and 1767 in HD) renamed to NBC Sports California;
- 2) Comcast SportsNet California Alternate (channel 768 and 1768 in HD) renamed to NBC Sports California Alternate;
- 3) Comcast SportsNet Bay Area (channel 770 and 1770 in HD) renamed to NBC Sports Bay Area;
- 4) Comcast SportsNet Bay Area Plus (channel 771) renamed to NBC Sports Bay Area Plus;
- 5) Comcast SportsNet Bay Area Alternate HD (channel 1771 in HD) renamed to NBC Sports Bay Area Alternate HD.

June 2017:

AT&T's contract with the programmer for the following channels are set to expire. While these channels will continue to be available to U-verse members so long as AT&T has the rights to carry them, if a reasonable agreement cannot be reached with the programmer the programming will no longer be available. AT&T may modify the channel location for the programming by moving them from their current channel location to a channel between 9501-9599, and if a reasonable longer term agreement cannot be reached with the programmers, we may lose the rights to carry them (listed in alphabetical order) in or after June 2017: Centroamerica TV (channel 3044), GMA Pinoy TV (channel 3683), iHeart Radio (channel 532 and 1532 in HD), MGM HD (channel 1116 in HD), Pasiones (channel 3018), Television Dominicana (channel 3047), and WAPA America (channel 3013).

Customers will be provided with written notification of the above: customer bills include a message referring them to the Legal Notices in USA Today on the first and third Tuesday of each month, and to the AT&T website att.com/u-verseprogrammingchanges, for information on programming changes.
