U-verse Programming Changes

AT&T's contracts with programmers for the content displayed on U-verse TV® service periodically expire, or may be terminated, but are usually re-negotiated or extended with no interruption or change for our U-verse members. Additionally, from time to time it is necessary to change channel line-ups as well as television package contents. The programming changes set forth below may occur as follows:

January 2018:

As previously noticed, AT&T's contract with the programmer for the following channels is set to expire. While these channels will continue to be available to U-verse members so long as AT&T has the rights to carry them, if a reasonable agreement cannot be reached with the programmer the programming will no longer be available. AT&T may modify the channel location for the programming by moving them from their current channel location to a channel between 9501 – 9599, and if a reasonable longer term agreement cannot be reached with the programmer, we may lose the rights to carry them (listed in alphabetical order) in or after January 2018: Sony Entertainment Television Asia (channel 3704), GOLTV (channel 656 and 1656 in HD).

February 2018:

As previously noticed, AT&T's contract with the programmer for the following channels is set to expire. While these channels will continue to be available to U-verse members so long as AT&T has the rights to carry them, if a reasonable agreement cannot be reached with the programmer the programming will no longer be available. AT&T may modify the channel location for the programming by moving them from their current channel location to a channel between 9501 – 9599, and if a reasonable longer term agreement cannot be reached with the programmer, we may lose the rights to carry them (listed in alphabetical order) in or after February 2018: Ovation (channel 385 and 1385 in HD), Stingray Karaoke (channel 96 and 1096 in HD), Stingray Music (channel 500, 531 and 1500, 1531 in HD).

March 2018:

AT&T's contract with the programmers for the following channels are set to expire. While these channels will continue to be available to U-verse members so long as AT&T has the rights to carry them, if a reasonable agreement cannot be reached with the programmers the programming will no longer be available. AT&T may modify the channel location for the programming by moving them from their current channel location to a channel between 9501 – 9599, and if a reasonable longer term agreement cannot be reached with the programmers, we may lose the rights to carry them (listed in alphabetical order) in or after March 2018: Havoc TV HD (channel 1490 in HD), World Fishing Network HD (channel 1679 in HD), MegaTV (channel 3008 in HD), SNY HD (channel 1704 in HD), U-verse Shopping Multiview application (channel 412 and 1412 in HD), and U-verse Paquete Espanol application (channel 3001).

Customers will be provided with written notification of the above: customer bills include a message referring them to the Legal Notices in USA Today on the first and third Tuesday of each month, and to the AT&T website att.com/u-verseprogrammingchanges, for information on programming changes.
