Re: Proposed Planning Commission Work Program FY2018-19

At the regularly scheduled Planning Commission meeting on February 13, 2018, the Commission discussed the upcoming fiscal year 2018-2019 work program. The Commission expressed the need for civility, communication, collaboration, and consensus. As a result, the Commission approved a motion to recommend for the consideration of the City Council additional projects to be included in the upcoming fiscal year work program. The projects include the following items:

- 1. Conduct study sessions/forums on the following topics:
  - Introduction to form-based codes/design;
  - State of traffic conditions in Cupertino and how traffic is measured + Transition from LOS to VMT;
  - Update and summary of State Housing bills.
- 2. Reconsider and reassess the City's allocation system and process.
- 3. Reevaluate the Heart of the City plan and objectives to be consistent with the rest of the city, state and local planning and design trends.
- 4. Introduce a higher design threshold to promote complete streets, connectivity of new developments, and compliance to the 2016 Bicycle Transportation Plan.
- 5. Consider the installation of parking meters as a design tool for parking and traffic control and alleviation.
