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#### CITY COUNCIL STAFF REPORT

Meeting: March 6, 2018

### **Subject**

Set the voluntary limit at \$29,000 for campaign expenditures for the November 6, 2018 City Council election.

#### Recommended Action

Adopt the draft resolution setting a voluntary campaign expenditure limit of \$29,000 for the November 6, 2018 City Council election.

#### **Discussion**

Beginning in 1997, the City Council has set voluntary campaign expenditure limits for each election in order to allow both candidates and officeholders to spend a lesser proportion of their time on fundraising and a greater proportion of their time communicating issues of importance to voters and constituents.

If a limit is established for the 2018 election, it would be voluntary, is not required, and would have no force of law. If a limit is established for the 2018 election and candidates indicate in writing their intention to abide by the limitation, a black diamond will be printed by their name in the ballot.

The \$29,000 limit was calculated based on the latest copy of the State's Report of Registration (27,874 registered voters in Cupertino) x 2.9% CPI, and rounded up.
