U-verse Programming Changes

AT&T's contracts with programmers for the content displayed on U-verse TV* service periodically expire, or may be terminated, but are usually re-negotiated or extended with no interruption or change for our U-verse members. Additionally, from time to time it is necessary to change channel line-ups as well as television package contents. The programming changes set forth below may occur as follows:

February 2018:

As previously noticed, AT&T's contracts with the programmers for the following channels are set to expire. While these channels will continue to be available to U-verse members so long as AT&T has the rights to carry them, if reasonable agreements cannot be reached with the programmers, the programming will no longer be available. AT&T may modify the channel locations for the programming by moving them from their current channel locations to channels between 9501 – 9599, and if reasonable longer term agreements cannot be reached with the programmers, we may lose the rights to carry them (listed in alphabetical order) in or after February 2018: Ovation (channel 385 and 1385 in HD), Stingray Karaoke (channel 96 and 1096 in HD), and Stingray Music (channel 500, 531 and 1500, 1531 in HD).

March 2018;

As previously noticed, AT&T's contracts with the programmers for the following channels are set to expire. While these channels will continue to be available to U-verse members so long as AT&T has the rights to carry them, if reasonable agreements cannot be reached with the programmers, the programming will no longer be available. AT&T may modify the channel locations for the programming by moving them from their current channel locations to channels between 9501 – 9599, and if reasonable longer term agreements cannot be reached with the programmers, we may lose the rights to carry them (listed in alphabetical order) in or after March 2018: Havoc TV HD (channel 1490 in HD), MegaTV (channel 3008 in HD), SNY HD (channel 1704 in HD), U-verse Shopping Multiview application (channel 412 and 1412 in HD), U-verse Paquete Espanol application (channel 3001); and World Fishing Network HD (channel 1679 in HD).

And the following channel: Newsy (channel 175 and 1175 in HD).

April 2018:

AT&T's contracts with the programmers for the following channels are set to expire. While these channels will continue to be available to U-verse members so long as AT&T has the rights to carry them, if reasonable agreements cannot be reached with the programmers, the programming will no longer be available. AT&T may modify the channel locations for the programming by moving them from their current channel locations to channels between 9501 – 9599, and if reasonable longer term agreements cannot be reached with the programmers, we may lose the rights to carry them (listed in alphabetical order) in or after April 2018: NFL Network (channel 630 and 1630 in HD); NFL RedZone (channel 1629 in HD); QVC (channel 420 and 1420 in HD); and QVC2 (channel 421).
