A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CUPERTINO CALLING FOR A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 6, 2018 TO FILL CITY COUNCIL SEATS, REQUESTING CONSOLIDATION WITH OTHER NOVEMBER ELECTIONS AND REQUESTING THAT THE REGISTRAR OF VOTERS CONDUCT THE ELECTION AND CANVASS THE VOTES

WHEREAS, November 6, 2018, is the date set by law for the election of Council members and for any City measure(s); and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk is enjoined by law to take all steps necessary for the holding of said election;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Cupertino:

- 1. A General Municipal Election is called for November 6, 2018, to fill the three City Council seats now occupied by Councilmembers Barry Chang, Darcy Paul, and Savita Vaidhyanathan.
- 2. The City of Cupertino requests that the Registrar of Voters of Santa Clara County conduct the elections and canvass the returns. The Registrar shall be reimbursed for all costs incurred by said services.
- 3. The City of Cupertino requests that said election be consolidated with other November elections and acknowledges that the consolidated election will be held and conducted in the manner prescribed in section 10418 of the Elections Code.
- 4. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to certify to the adoption of this resolution and to transmit a copy hereof so certified to the Registrar of Voters and to the Board of Supervisors of Santa Clara County.
- 5. The City Clerk is authorized and directed to publish a notice of election within the time and in the manner specified in California Elections Code Division 12, Chapter 2 (commencing with section 12101).
